What is a seal ? *See the definitions that follow.*

Seal *noun*

1. a device or substance that is used to join two things together so as to prevent them from coming apart or to prevent anything from passing between them.
2. the state or fact of being joined or rendered impervious with a seal.
3. a piece of wax, lead, or other material with an individual design stamped into it, attached to a document to show that it has come from the person who claims to have issued it.
4. the obligation on a priest not to divulge anything said during confession.



Seal *verb*

1. fasten or close securely.
2. prevent something from escaping by closing a container or opening.
3. isolate an area by preventing or monitoring entrance to and exit from it.
4. apply a nonporous coating to (a surface) to make it impervious.
